Preliminary Design Studies

• Award Amounts:

~\$50,000

• Cadence:

Annual

Key Requirements:

- Applicants must be municipalities
- Municipalities can apply on behalf of a private owner

- Program Goals:
 - Help dam owners in the early planning phase to assess risks and opportunities of dam removal
 - Build a solid design foundation to pursue dam removal
- Type of Assistance:
 - Selected projects are eligible for engineering services contracted and managed directly by DER
- Tips for Successful Applications:
 - Public safety and climate change resilience benefits prioritized



Priority Projects Program

• Award Amounts:

 Varies based on program budget and project need

• Cadence:

- ~Every 2 years
- Key Requirements:
 - Dam owner must be committed to dam removal

- Program Goals:
 - Restore riverine function, Improve climate change resilience, eliminate public safety risks
 - Assist dam owners to remove unwanted dams
- Type of Assistance:
 - Technical Assistance and Financial Assistance (grants and direct contracts) for all phases
- Tips for Successful Applications:
 - Demonstrate both environmental and community benefits
 - Demonstrate community or partner support



Partnerships Program

Award Amounts:

\$100,000 -\$200,000 per partnership organization per year

• Cadence:

Expansion planned for 2026/27

• Key Requirements:

Applicants must be a 501c3 or Regional Planning Agency

- Program Goals:
 - Building regional capacity and implementing restoration projects
- Type of Assistance:
 - Capacity building funding and project implementation funding
- Tips for Successful Applications:
 - Regional based and long-term restoration and resiliency focused
 - Action oriented organizations
 - Collaboratively and equitably governed
