

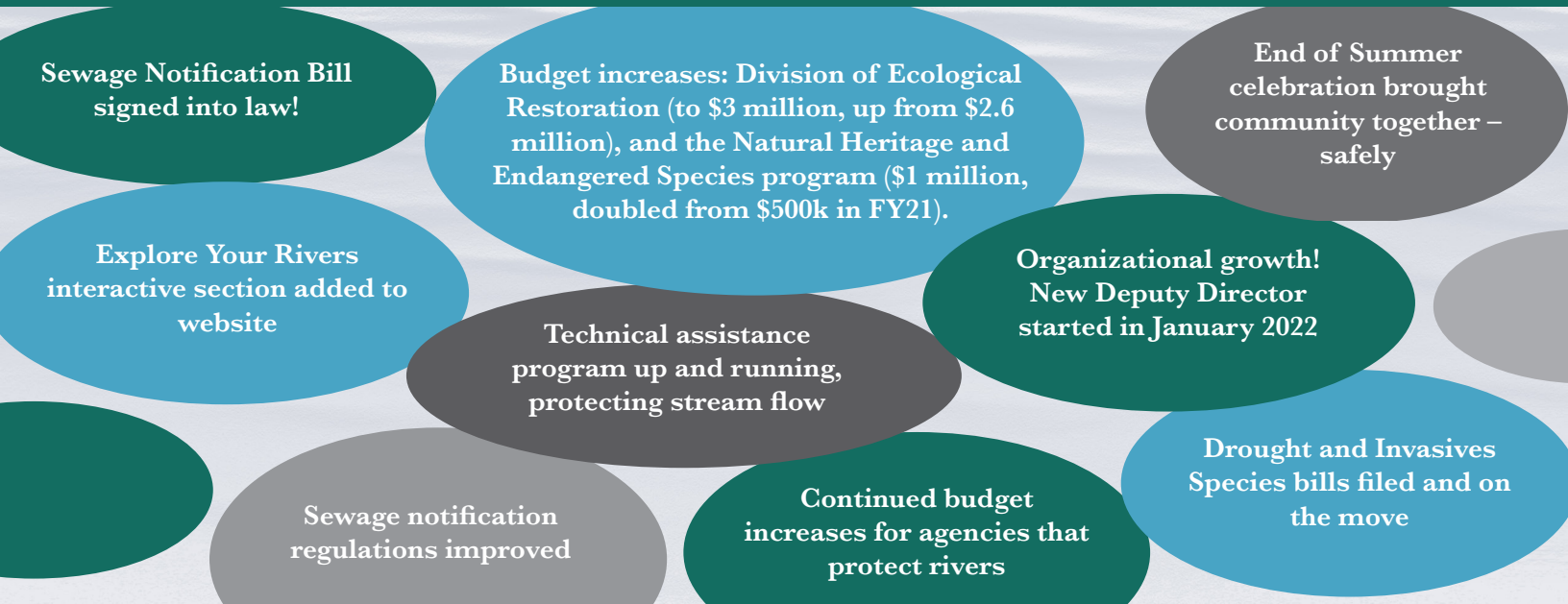

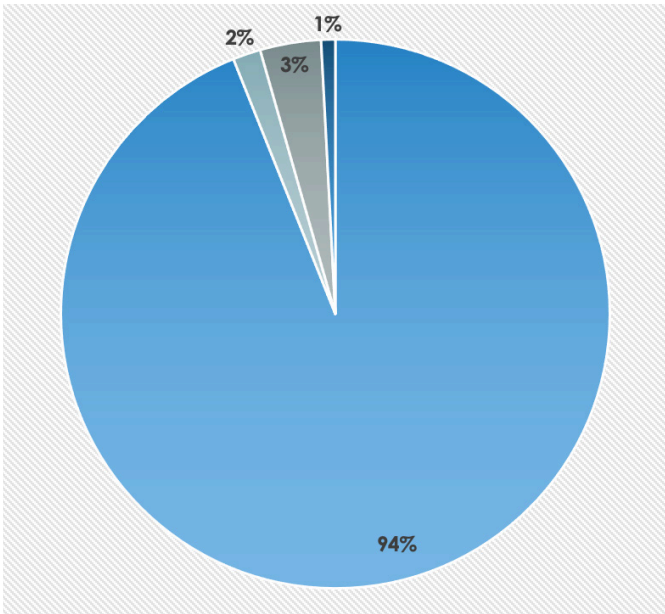

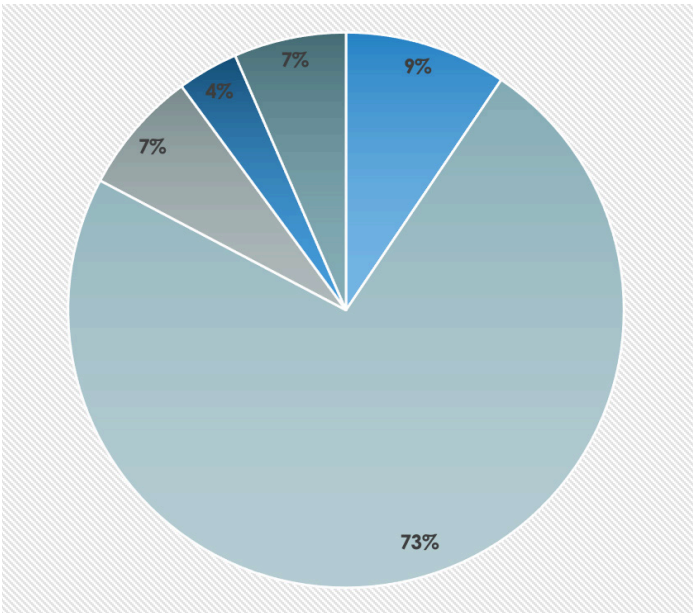


FINANCIALS

TRANSFORMATIONAL GIFT!

Massachusetts Rivers Alliance had an exciting start to 2021 with a generous challenge match from an anonymous donor: a multi-year transformational gift of \$550,000. **A LEGISLATIVE WIN!****A NEW LAW WITH IMPORTANT PROTECTIONS.**

With the passage of our Sewage Notification Act in February, 2021 saw a win for rivers, public health, and environmental justice. The new law requires public notification when there is a discharge of untreated or partly treated sewage into a river, an occurrence that happens far more frequently than most people realize, particularly in rivers flowing through urban areas. Over 1 billion gallons of raw or partially treated sewage entered Massachusetts' waterways in 2021. Massachusetts communities with higher concentrations of non-white, non-English speaking, and poorer residents, including several in the Merrimack and Mystic watersheds, have twice as many sewage spills than whiter, wealthier towns. Passage of this law took the proverbial village of legislators, municipal leaders, conservation partners, and individual advocates over several years, and is a testament to the growing power of our community. Of course, this is just one step in the journey to eliminating these spills altogether – the next challenge.

PROTECTING STREAMFLOW.

Climate change is bringing not just floods, but droughts to New England, with two recent Massachusetts droughts in 2016 and 2020. Protecting the sustainability of our rivers – and water supplies – in the face of this threat remains a thorny challenge, but we are making progress. In 2021, we partnered with a diverse set of stakeholders on several fronts to keep our streams from drying up during droughts. These efforts included:

- A technical assistance program to help member organizations use the Water Management Act to protect local streams
- Supporting a drought bill that would allow the governor to curtail lawn-watering during droughts
- Supporting a MassDEP initiative to bring more consistency to municipal water management across the state during droughts
- Working with the Ipswich River Watershed Association and American Rivers to leverage the group's 2021 Endangered Rivers designation to protect streamflow

CONNECTING PEOPLE TO RIVERS.

We were also thrilled to debut “Exploring Your Rivers,” a new section of our website created to help people across Massachusetts discover and enjoy their local rivers, in a canoe or kayak, holding a fishing rod or camera, riding a bike, or using their own two feet – or a wheelchair. We started work on this project in 2020; six talented interns later (and with significant staff support and member group feedback), we rolled the site out. 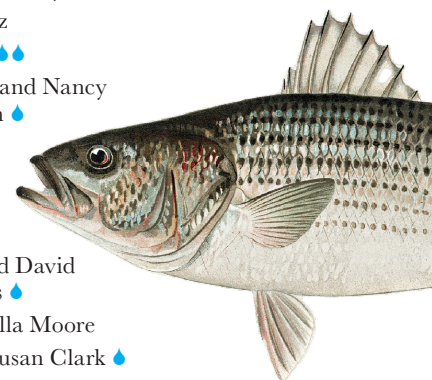

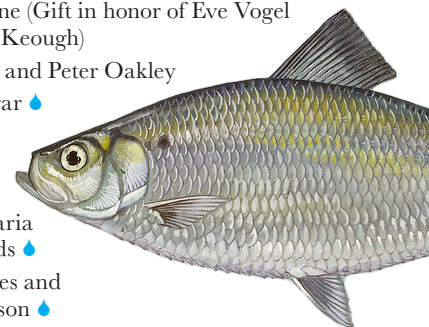
